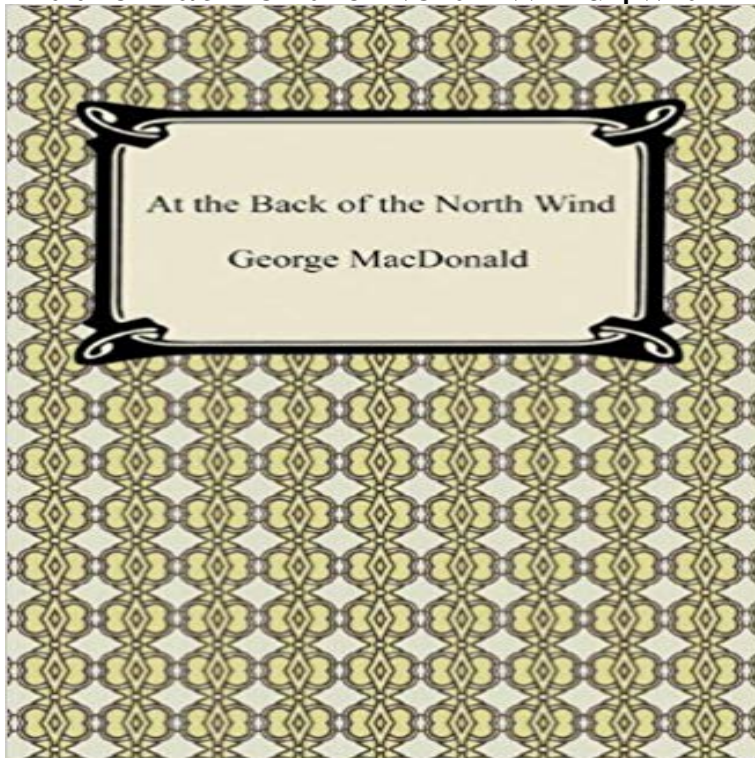


At the Back of the North Wind [with Biographical Introduction]
