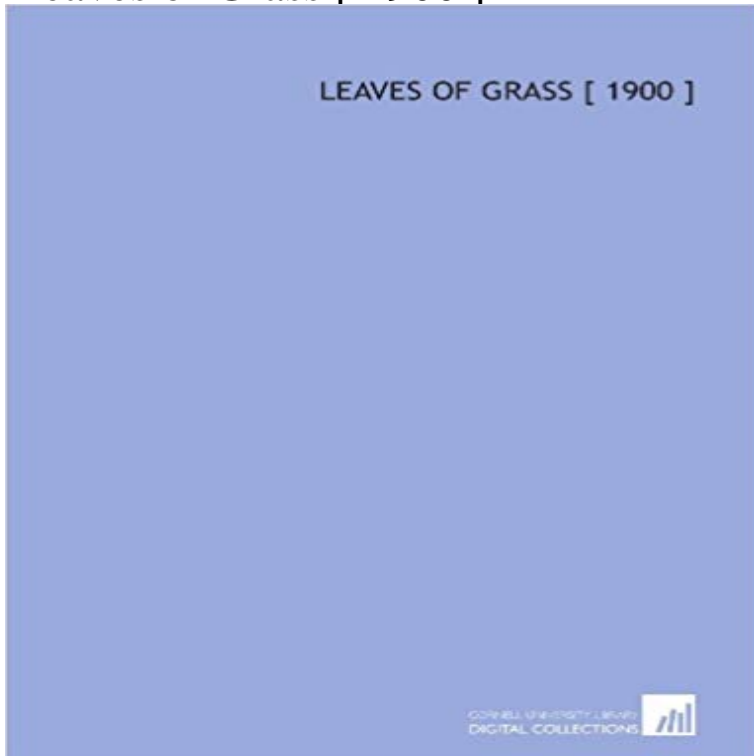


Leaves of Grass [1900]
