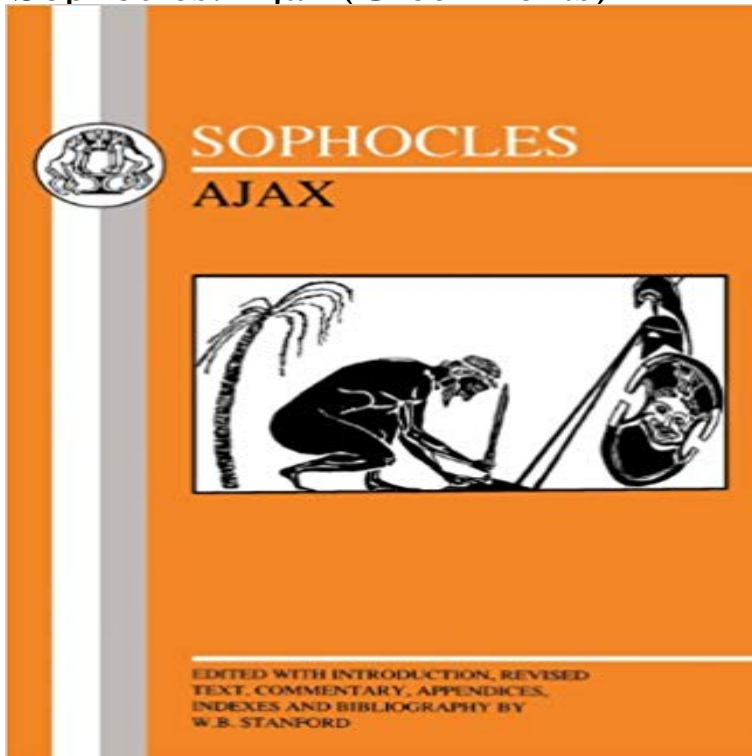


## Sophocles: Ajax (Greek Texts)
