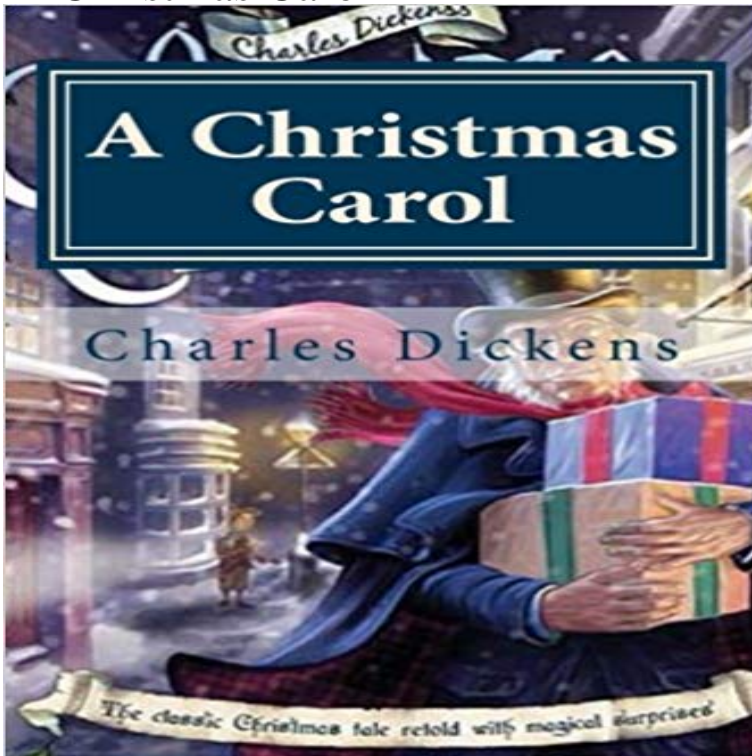


A Christmas Carol
