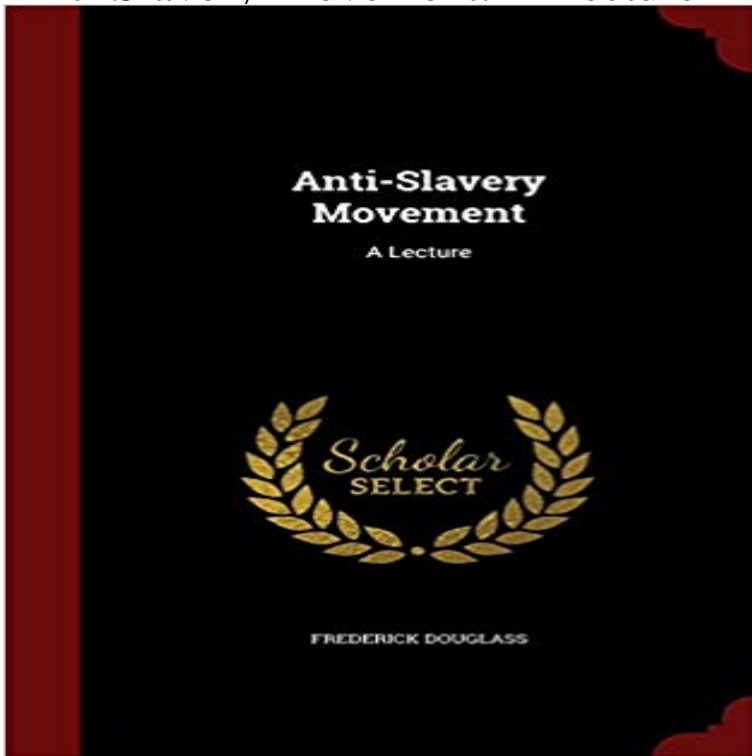

After escaping from slavery in Maryland, he became a national leader of the abolitionist movement in Massachusetts . Douglass later referred to this as the first decidedly antislavery lecture he had ever heard.
