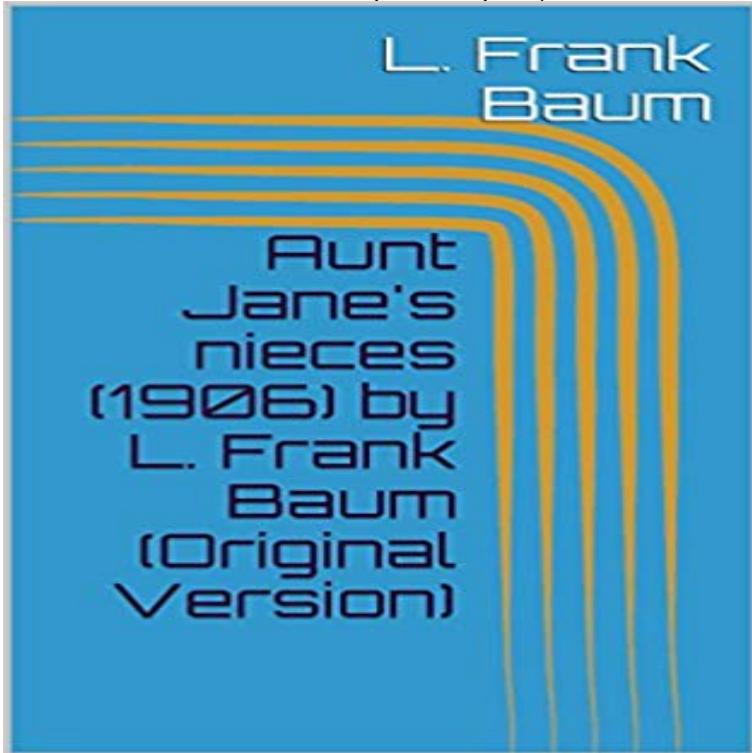


Aunt Janes nieces (1906) by L. Frank Baum (Original Version)
