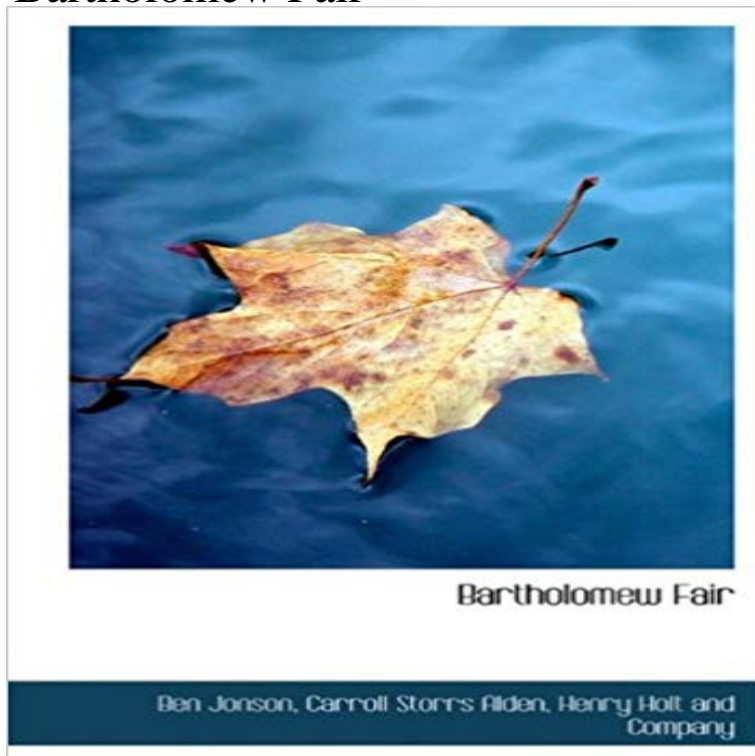


Bartholomew Fair
