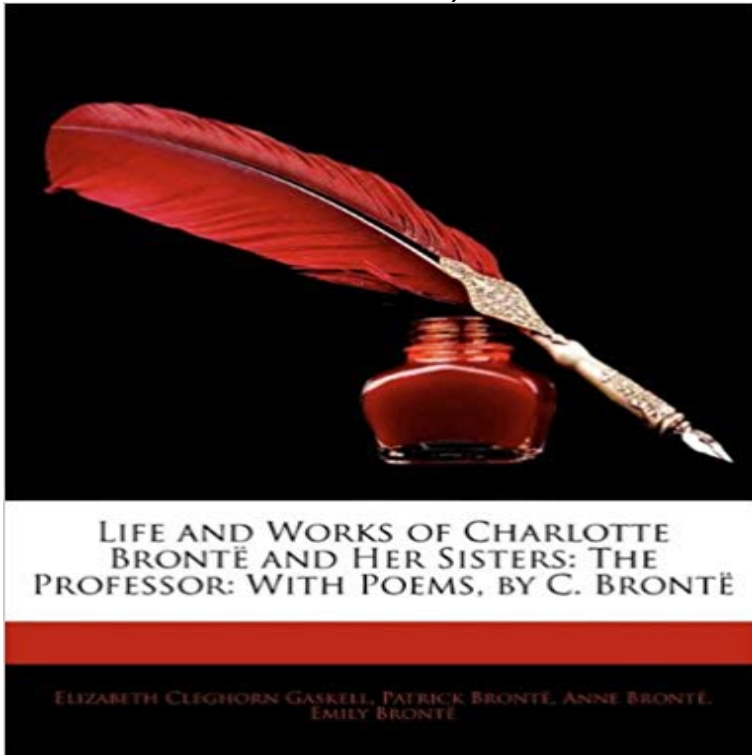


The Professor: With Poems, by C. Bronte (Life and Works of Charlotte Bronte and Her Sisters)
