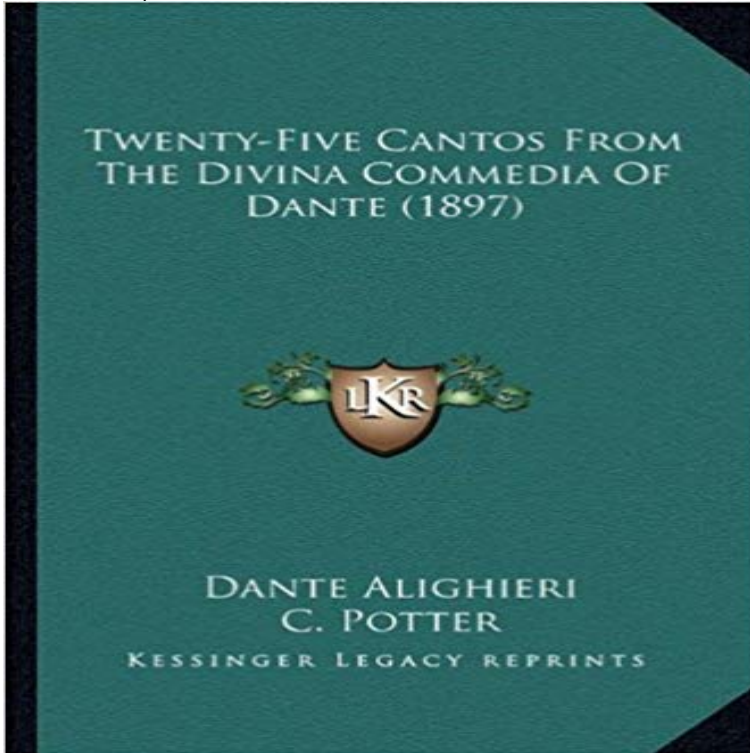


Twenty-Five Cantos From The Divina Commedia Of Dante (1897)
