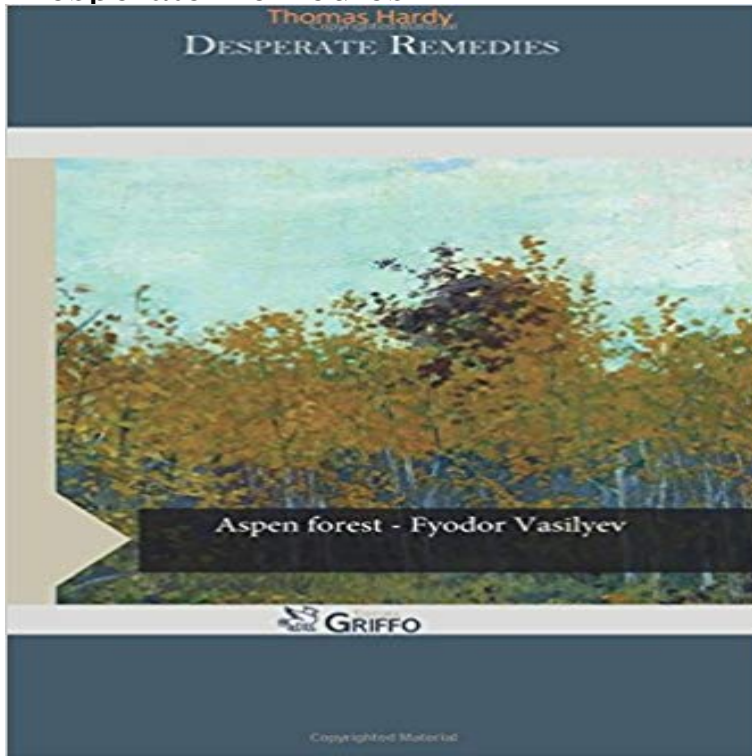


Desperate Remedies
