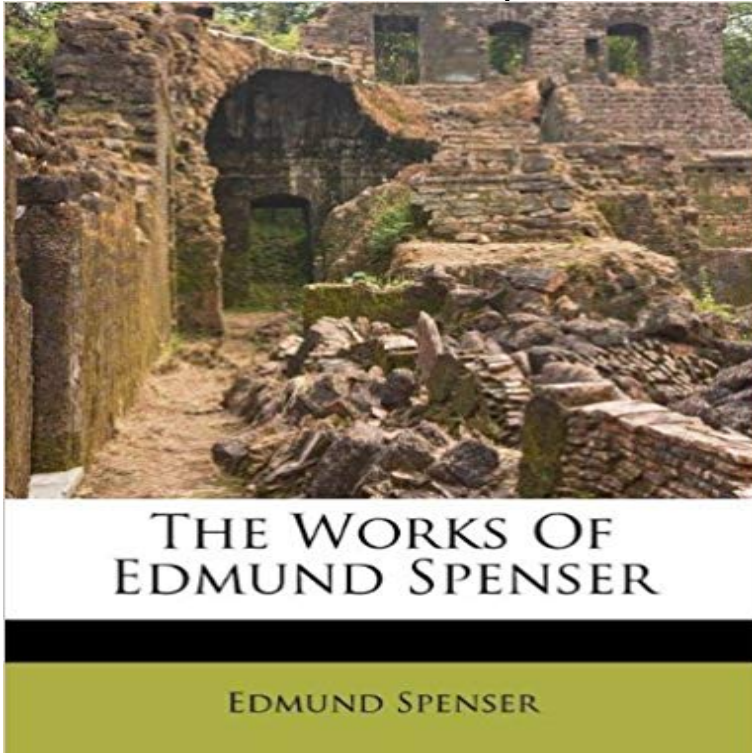


# The Works Of Edmund Spenser
