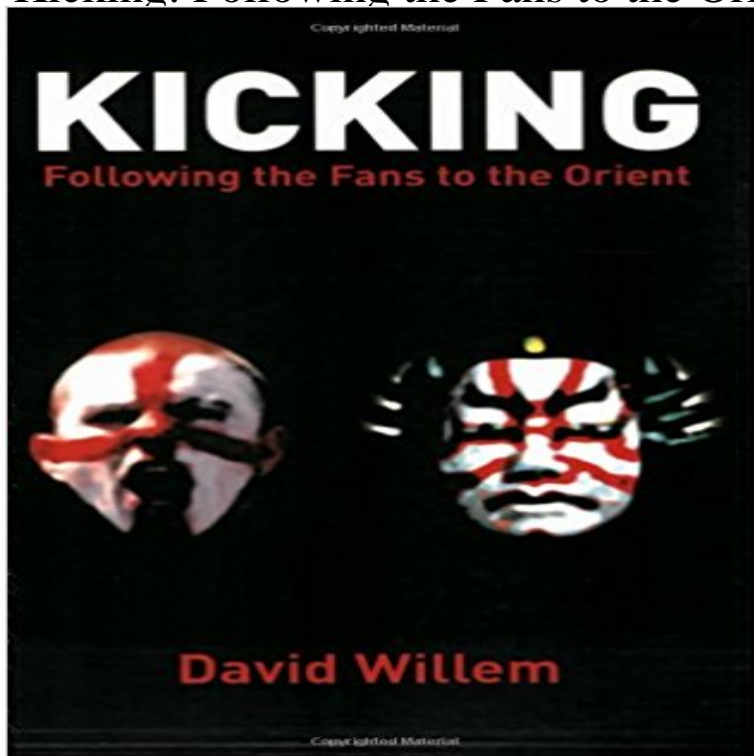


Kicking: Following the Fans to the Orient
