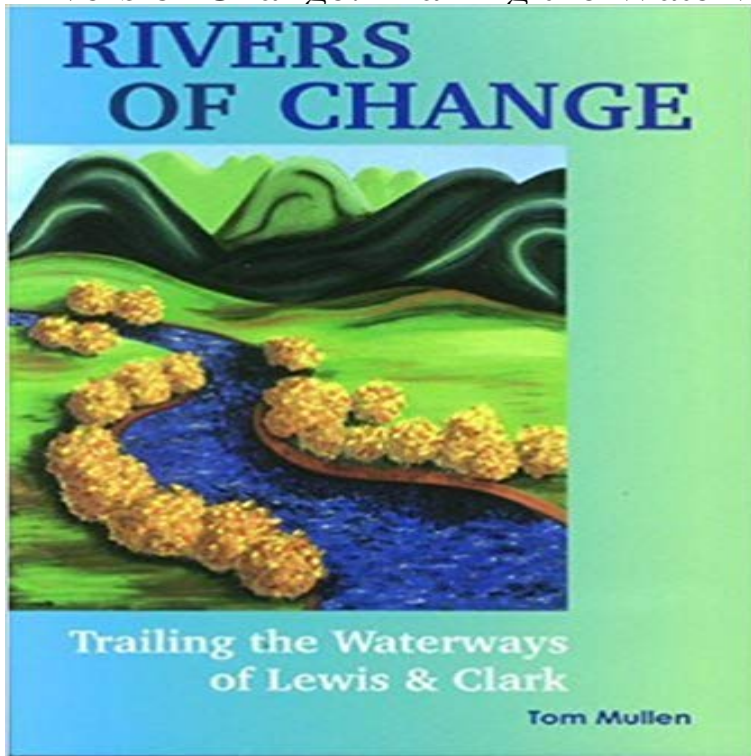


Rivers of Change: Trailing the Waterways of Lewis and Clark
