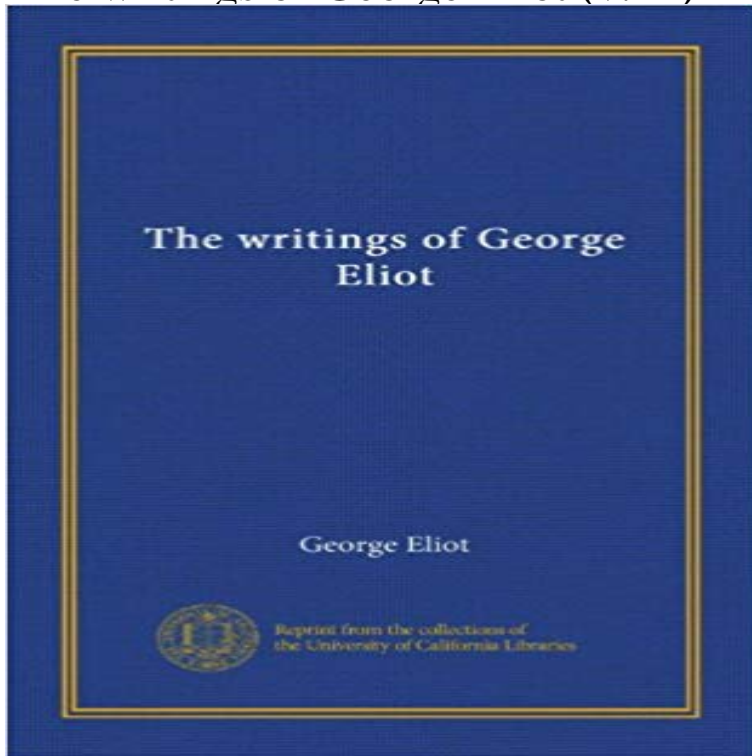


The writings of George Eliot (v.24)
