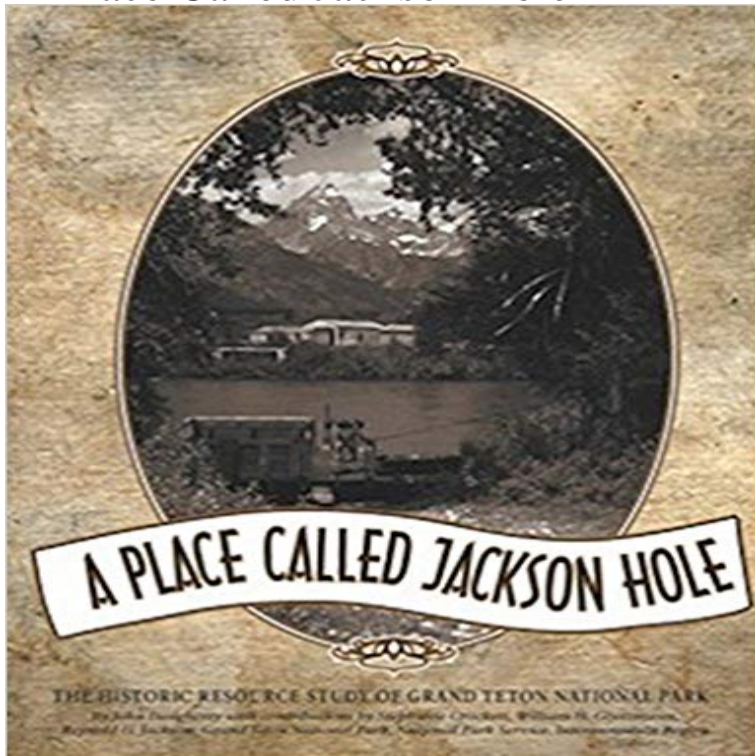


A Place Called Jackson Hole
