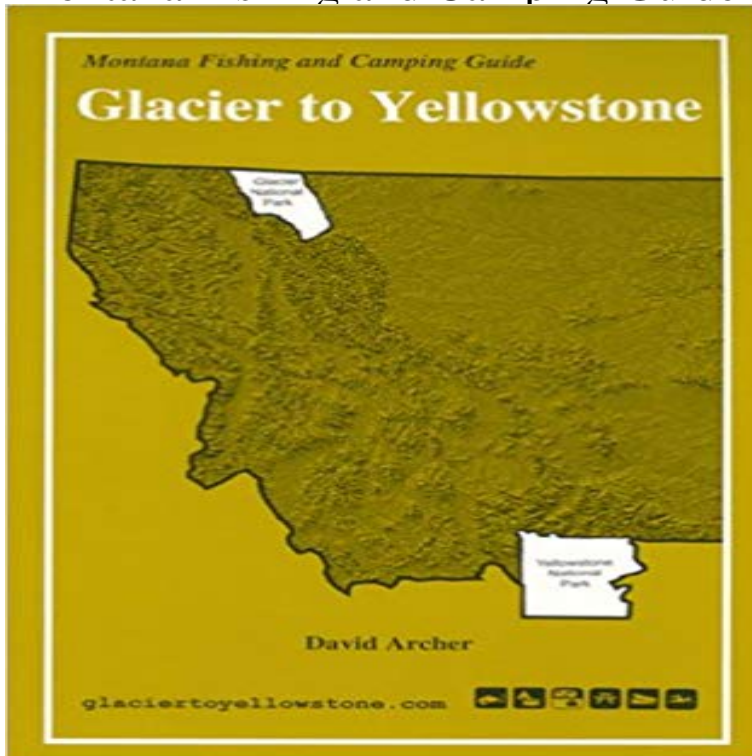


Montana Fishing and Camping Guide - Glacier to Yellowstone

Fishing in both parks is covered as well as directions and information to over 50 creeks and lesser known rivers. The book is replete with photographs, and detailed information is provided for fishing specific waters. Icon symbols and mileage marker designations provide quick reference while you are traveling. A section, Accommodations and Services is provided for each of the three regions.
