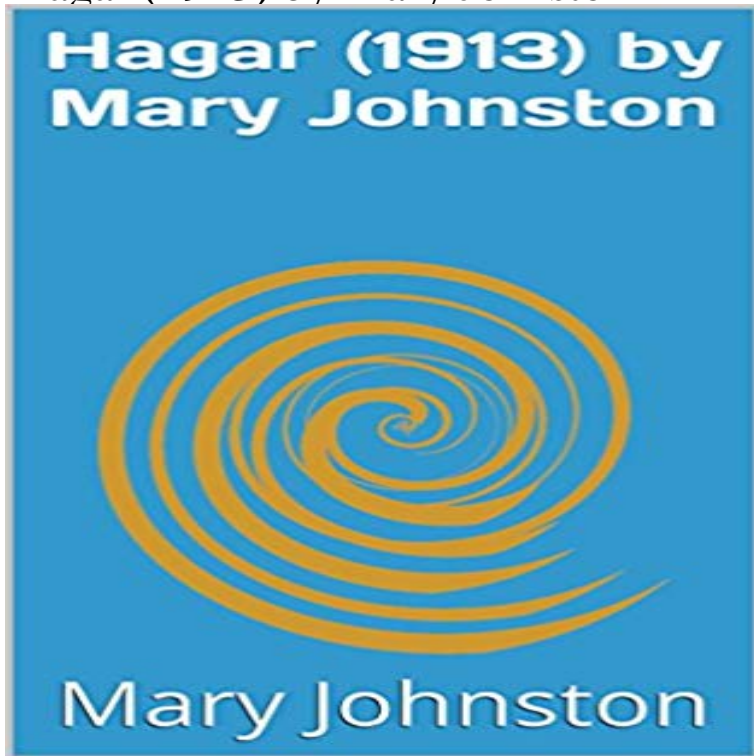


Hagar (1913) by Mary Johnston
