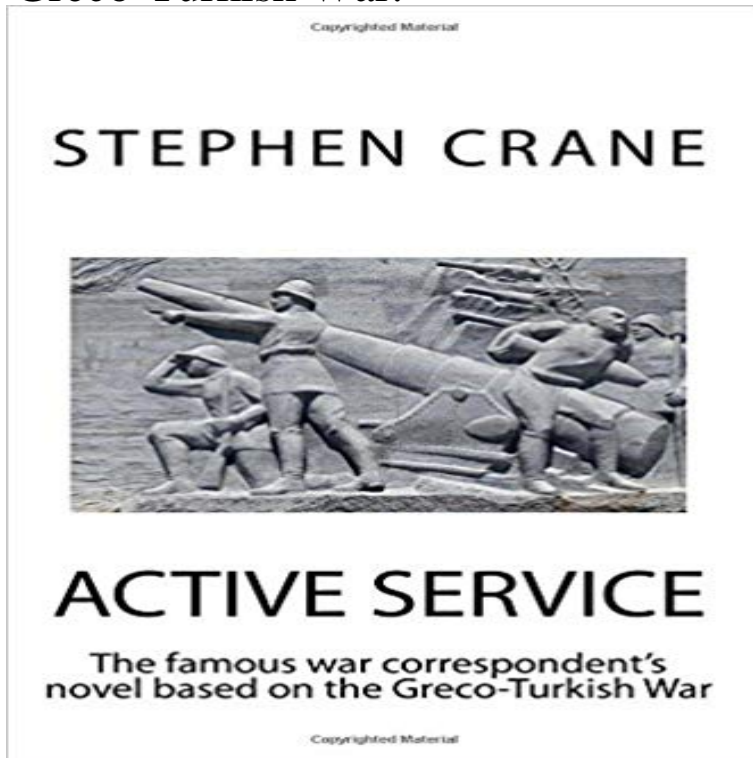


Active Service: The famous war correspondents novel based on the Greco-Turkish War.
