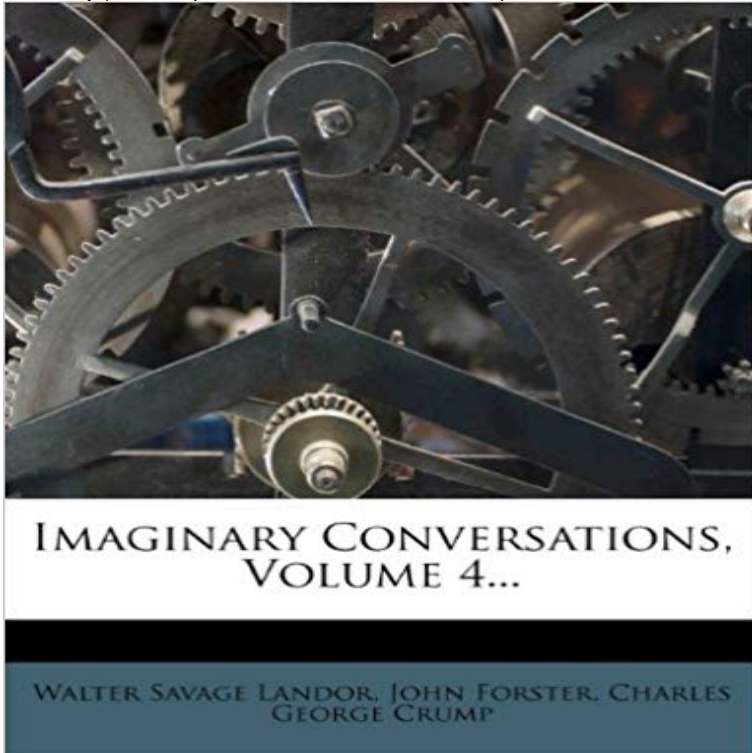


## Imaginary Conversations, Volume 4...
