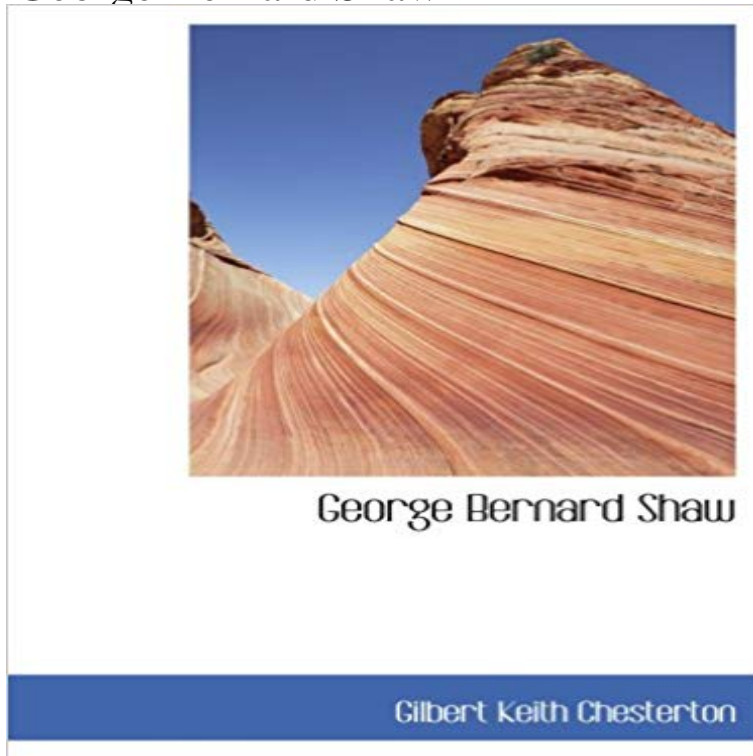


George Bernard Shaw
