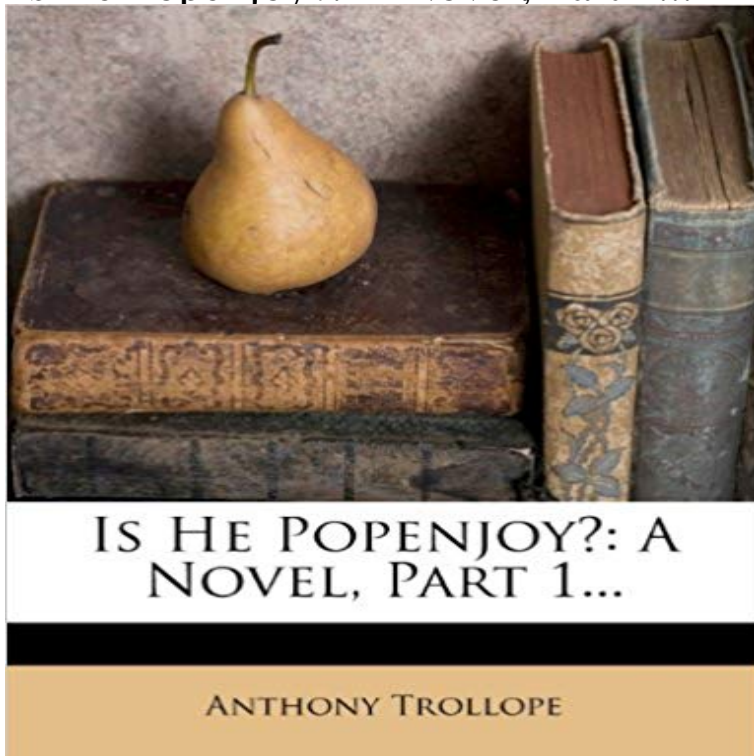


Is He Popenjoy?: A Novel, Part 1...
