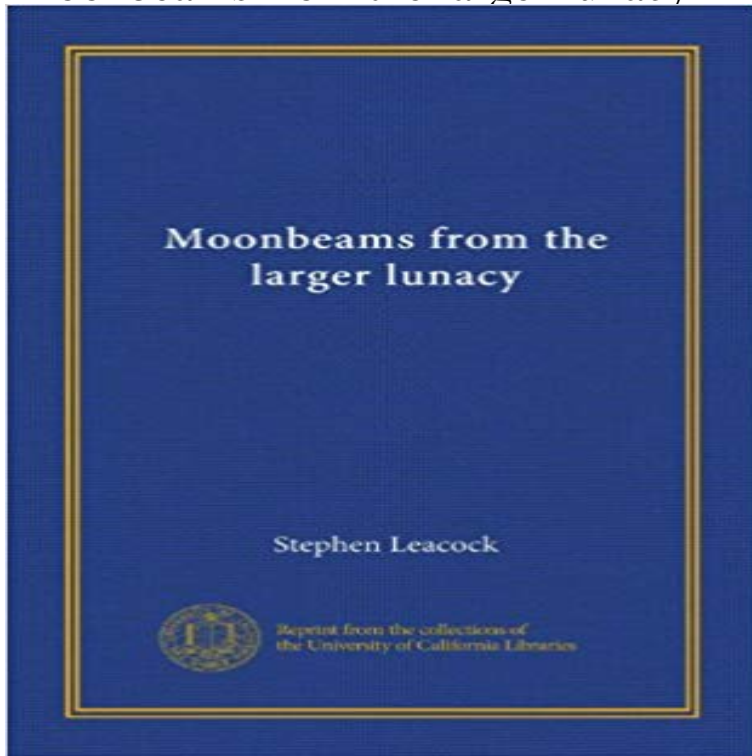


Moonbeams from the larger lunacy
