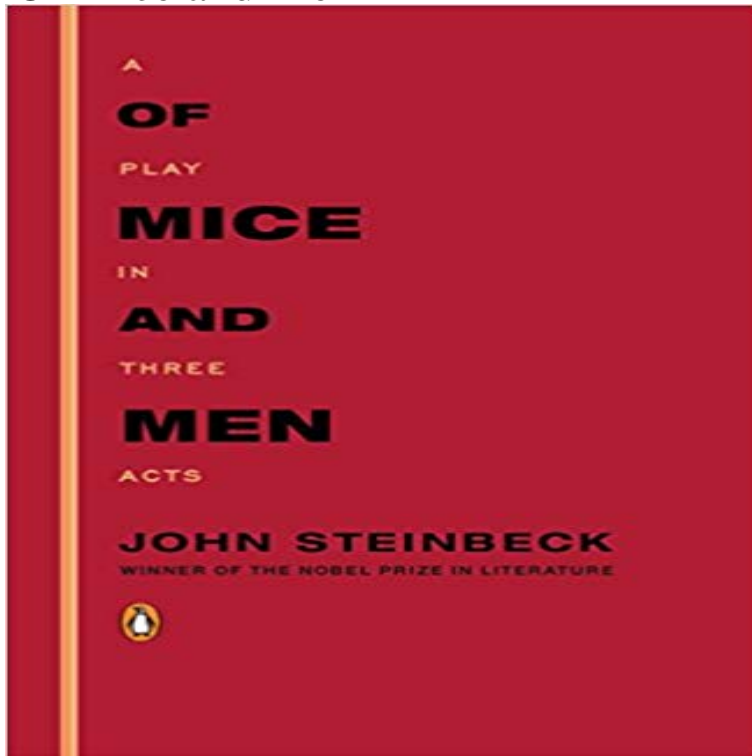


Of Mice and Men
