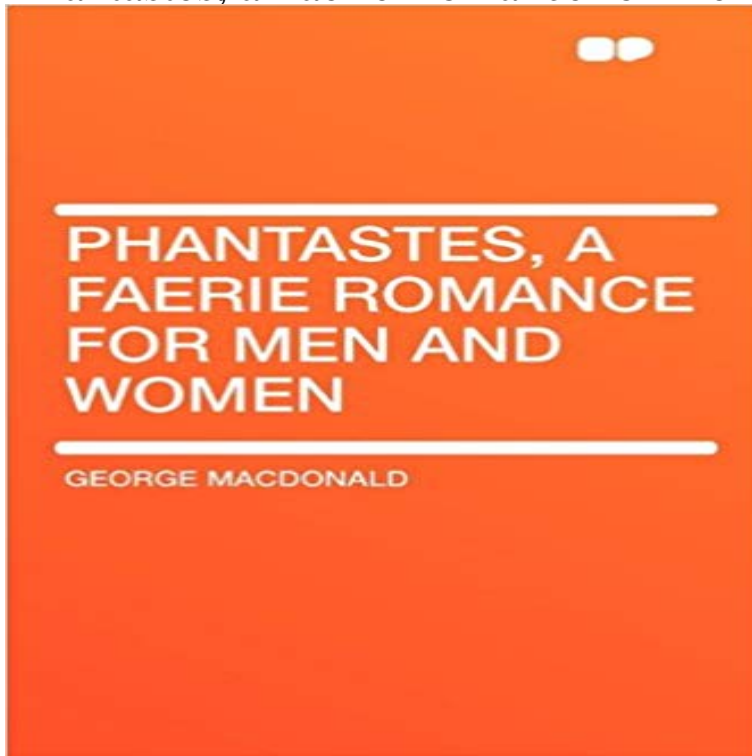


Phantastes, a Faerie Romance for Men and Women
