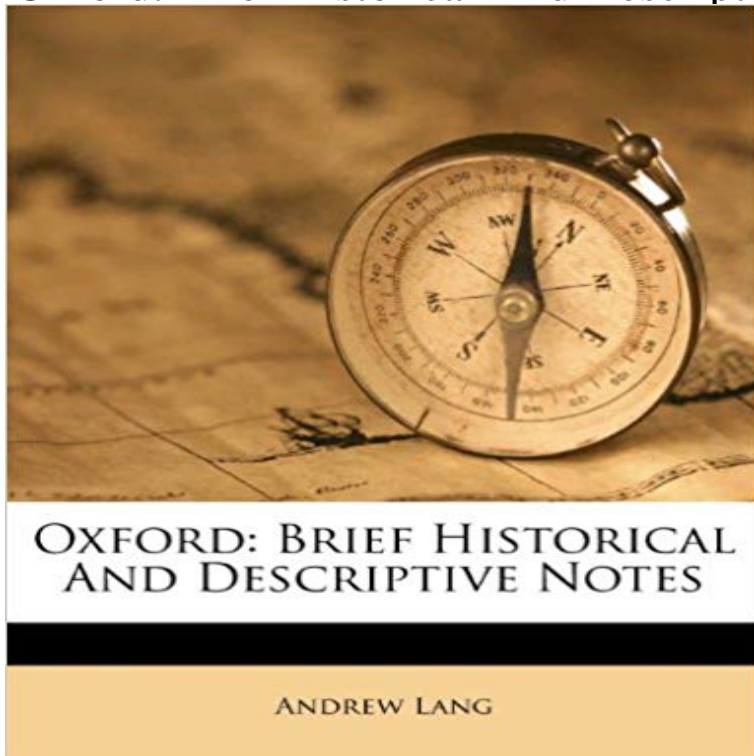


Oxford: Brief Historical And Descriptive Notes
