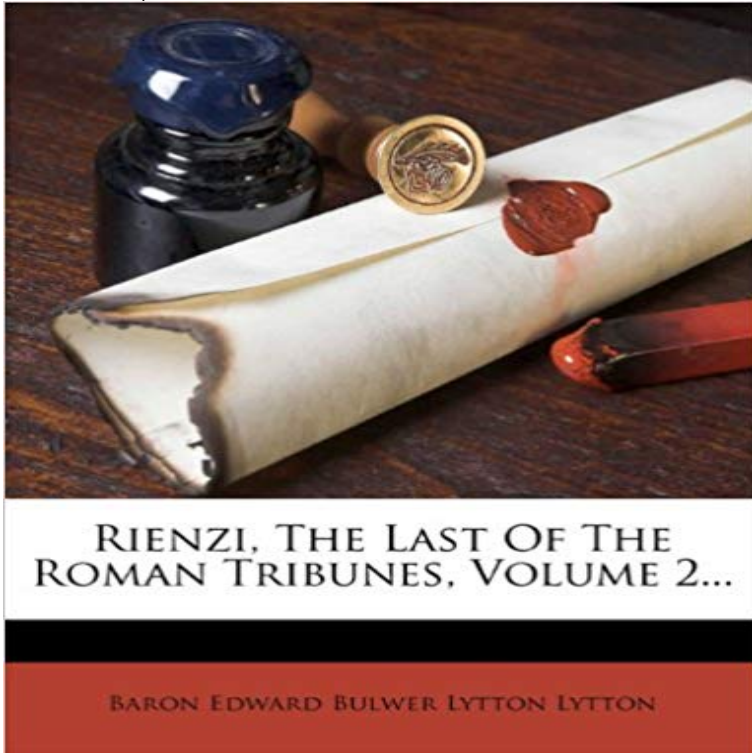


Rienzi, The Last Of The Roman Tribunes, Volume 2...
