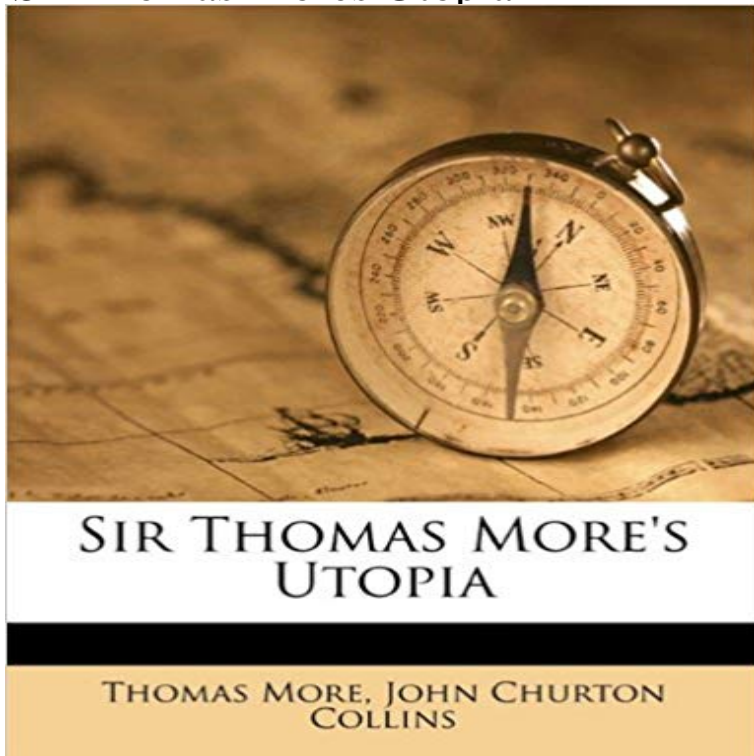


Sir Thomas Mores Utopia
