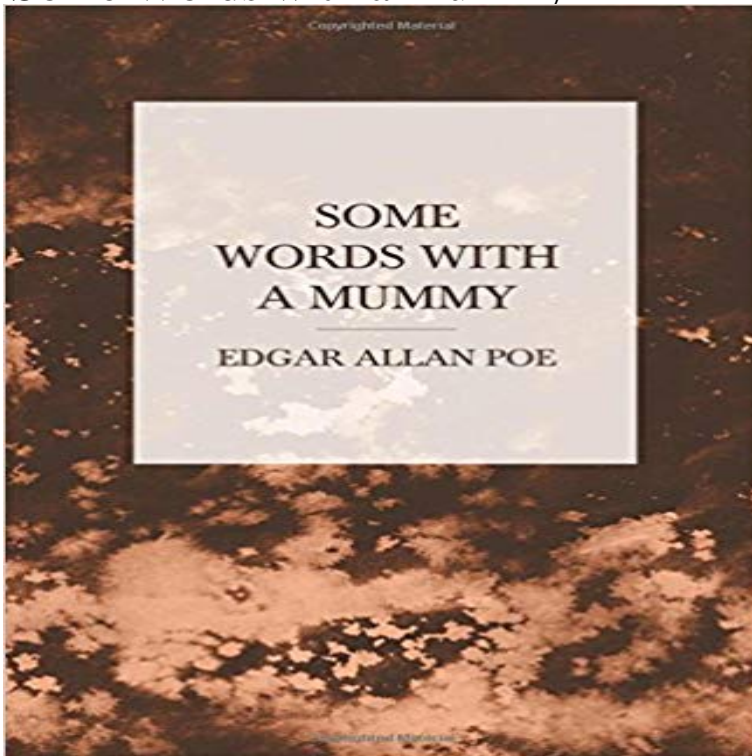


Some Words with a Mummy
