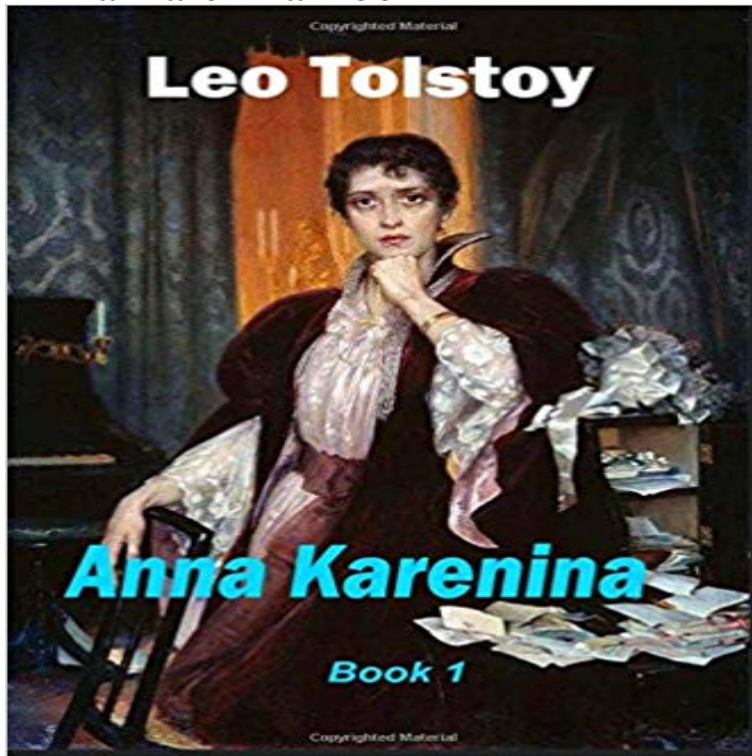


Anna Karenina Book 1
