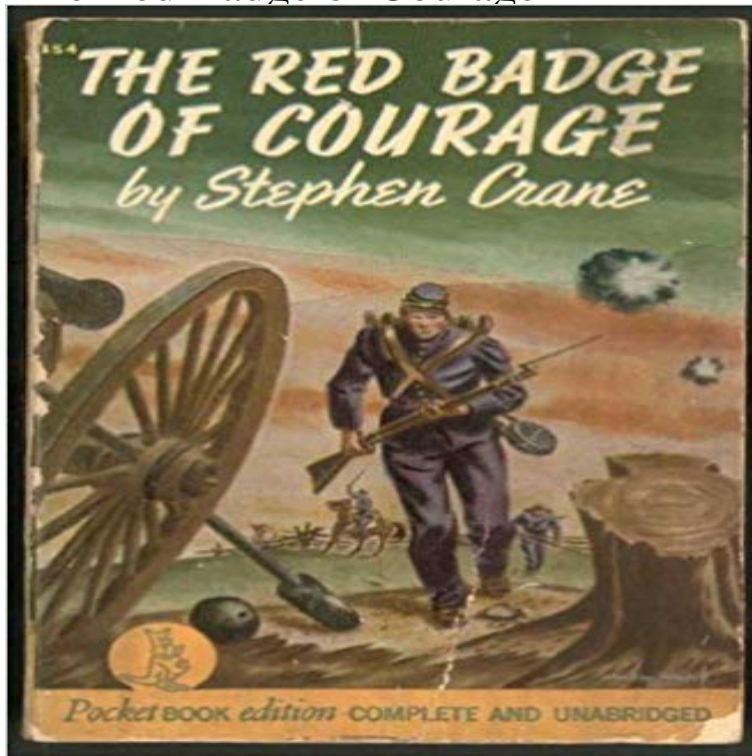


The Red Badge of Courage
