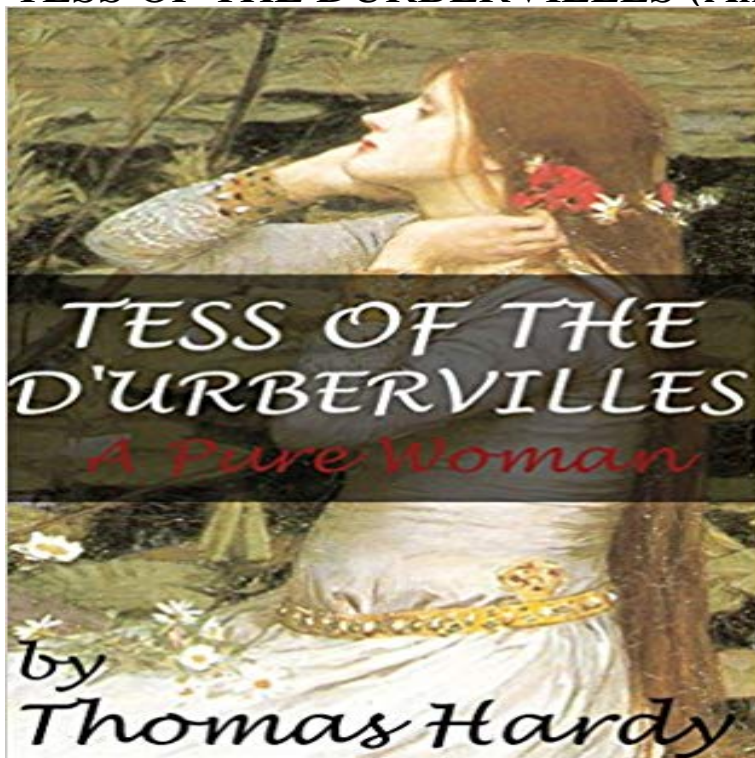


TESS OF THE DURBERVILLES (Annotated)
