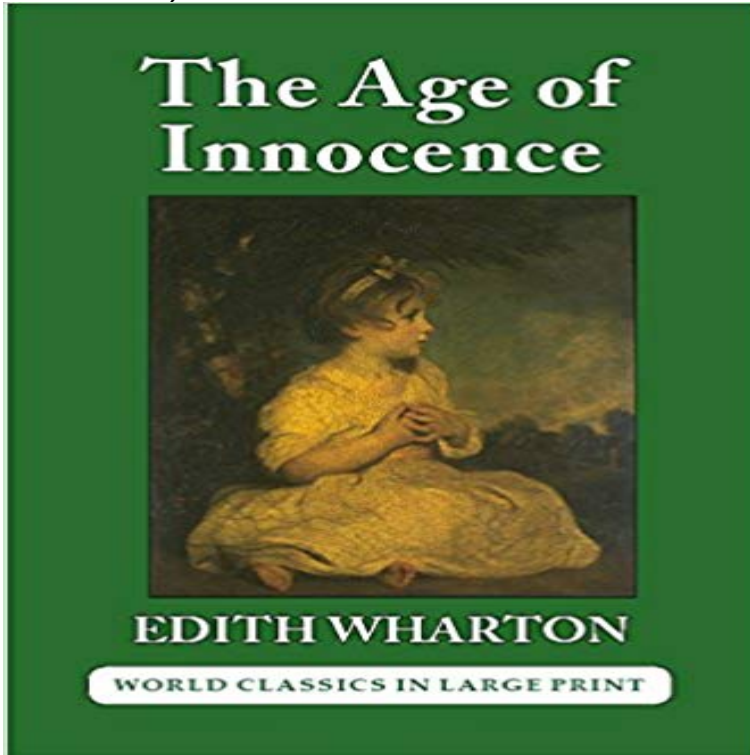


The Age of Innocence (World Classics in Large Print, American Authors)
