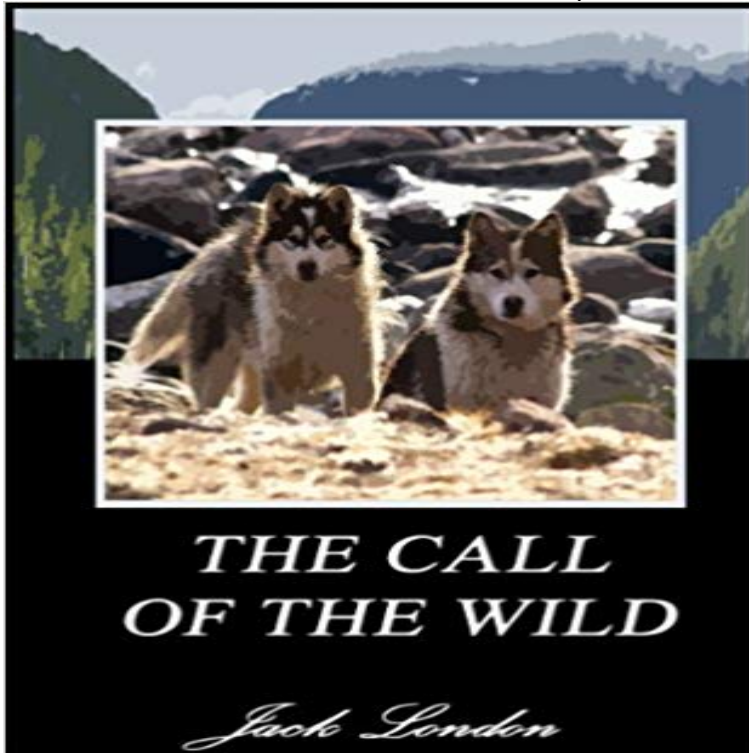


THE CALL OF THE WILD (Annotated)
