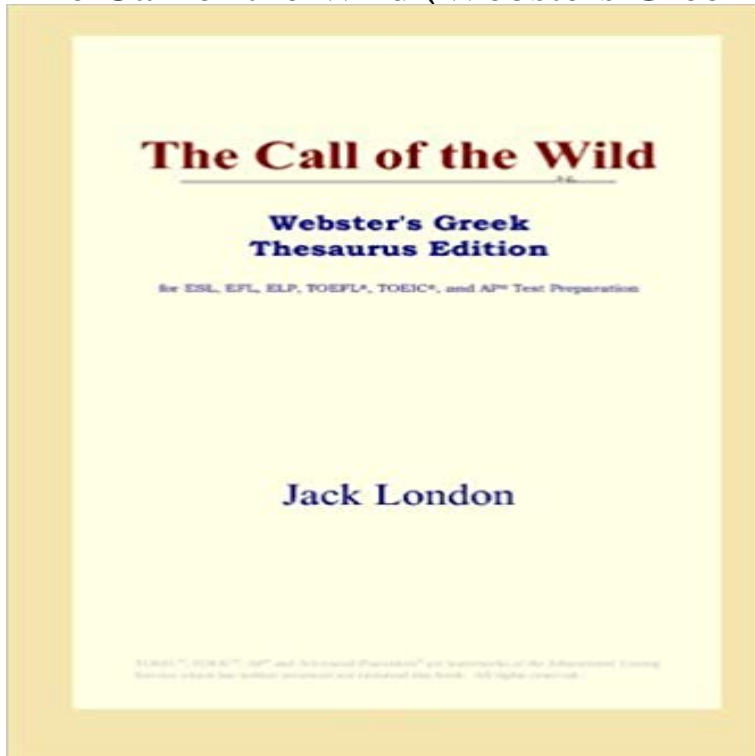


The Call of the Wild (Websters Greek Thesaurus Edition)
