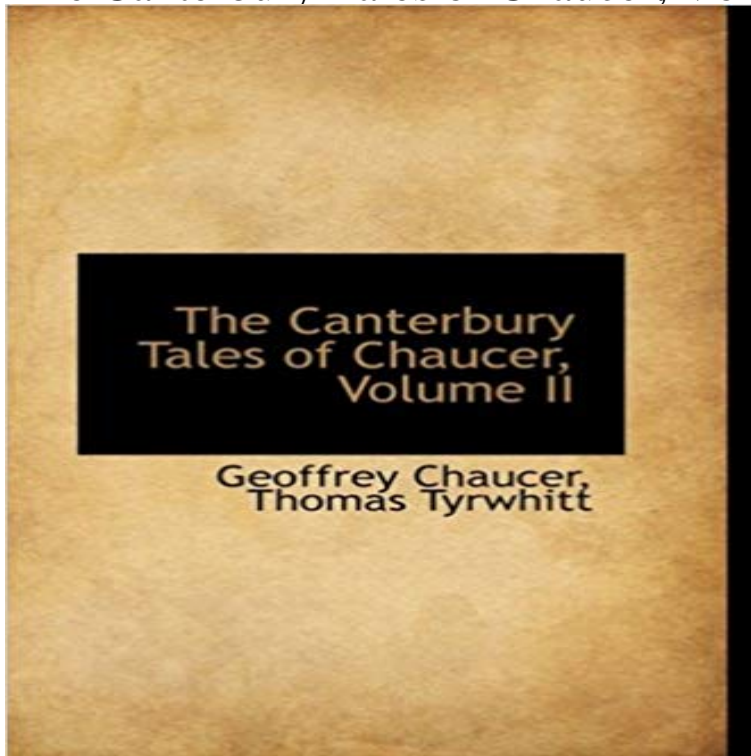


The Canterbury Tales of Chaucer, Volume II
