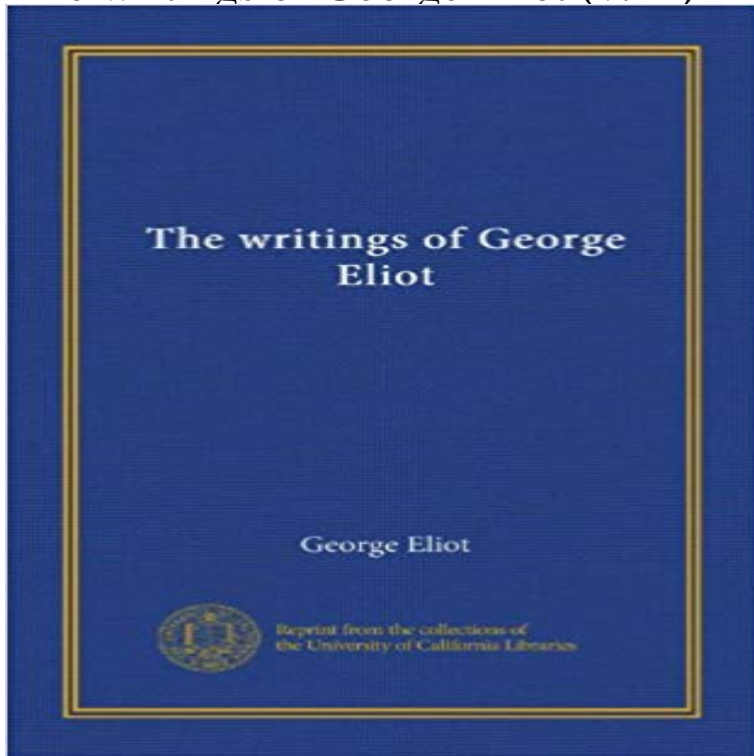


The writings of George Eliot (v.21)
