
The Mothers Recompense



This early work by Edith Wharton was originally published in 1925 and we are now republishing it with a brand new introductory biography. The Mothers Recompense is a novel about a woman who abandoned her husband and child and who returns to her home city of New York after spending years in exile. Edith Wharton was born in New York City in 1862. Whartons first poems were published in Scribners Magazine. In 1891, the same publication printed the first of her many short stories, titled Mrs. Mansteys View. Over the next four decades, they along with other well-established American publications such as Atlantic Monthly, Century Magazine, Harpers and Lippincotts regularly published her work.
