
Through Jaguar Eyes: Crossing the Amazon Basin

In February 1993 Benedict Allen became the first Westener to make the crossing at its widest point. Benedict Allens plan in setting out to cross the Amazon Basin was to place his life in the hands of the remote Matses, the jaguar people - Indians who aspired to all the grace and strength of the powerful cat, tatooing their faces with jaguar stripes and placing bamboo spikes in their no0ses to resemble whiskers. From the foothills of the Ecuadorian volcano Cotopaxi he descended into Columbia and forbidden cocaine traffikers country. Eluding a hitman from a drug gang, he entered Peru and made contact with the Matses. For two months he was taught how to make hunting traps and learnt the properties of plants. Then Benedict, jokingly dubbed The Man Without fear by the Indians, had to put his newly acquired knowledge knowledgr to the test.
