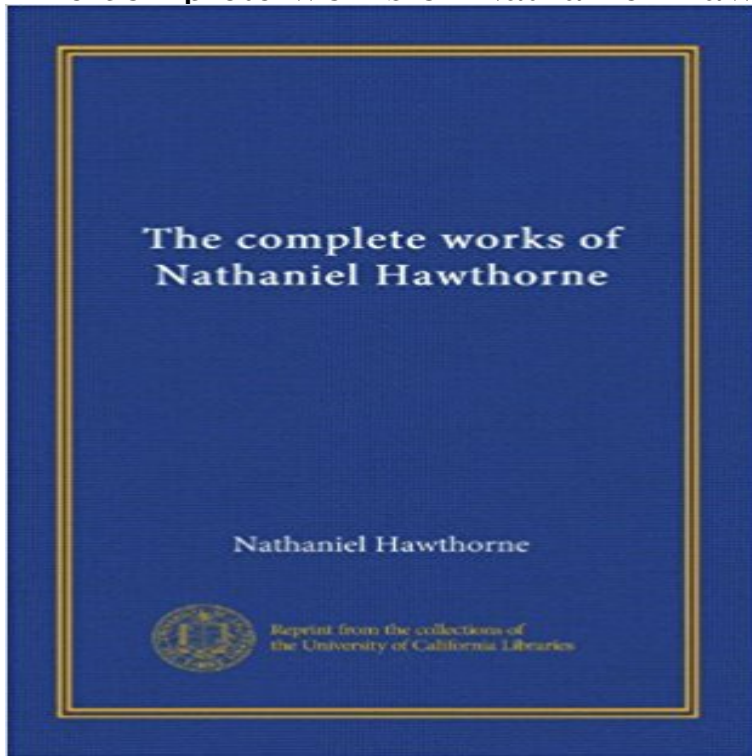


## The complete works of Nathaniel Hawthorne (v.02)
