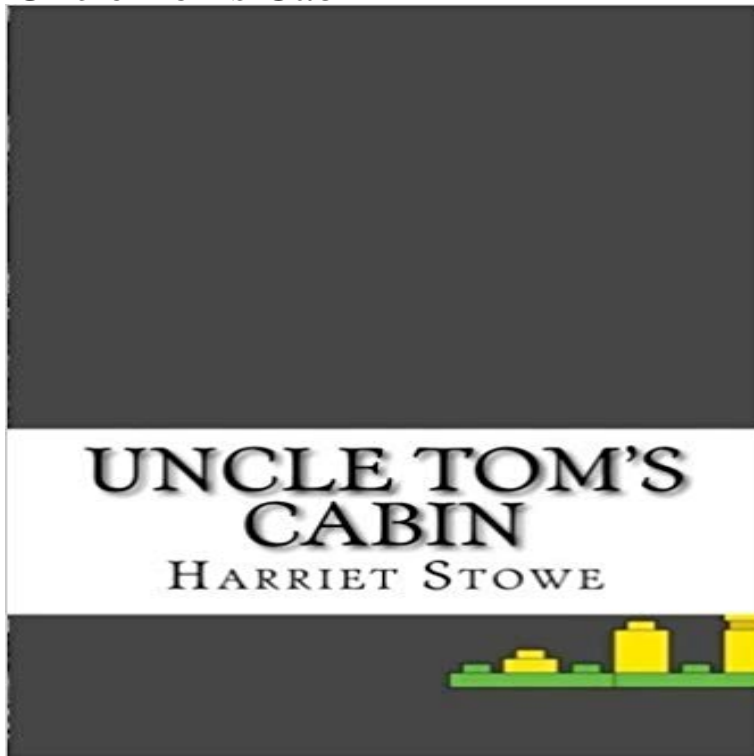


Uncle Toms Cabin
