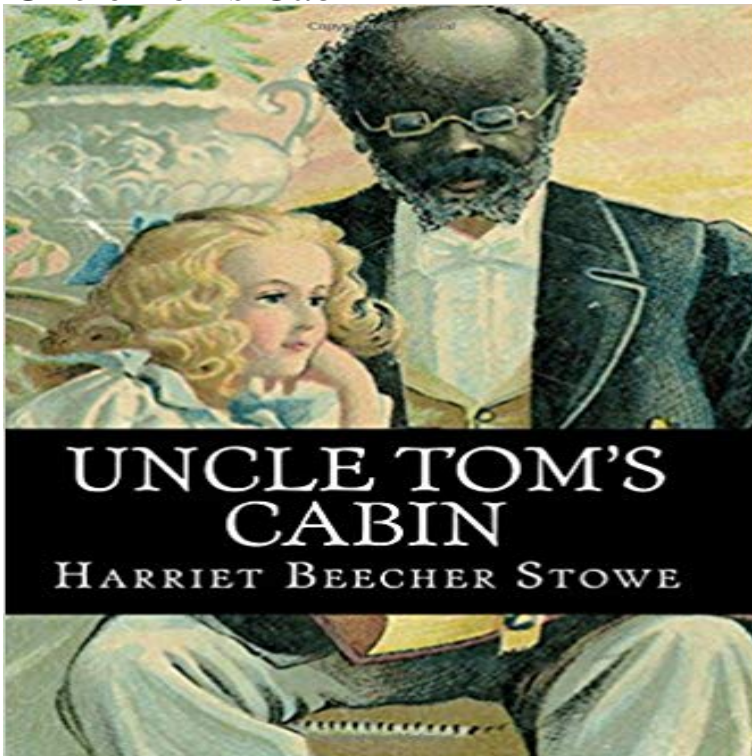


## Uncle Toms Cabin
