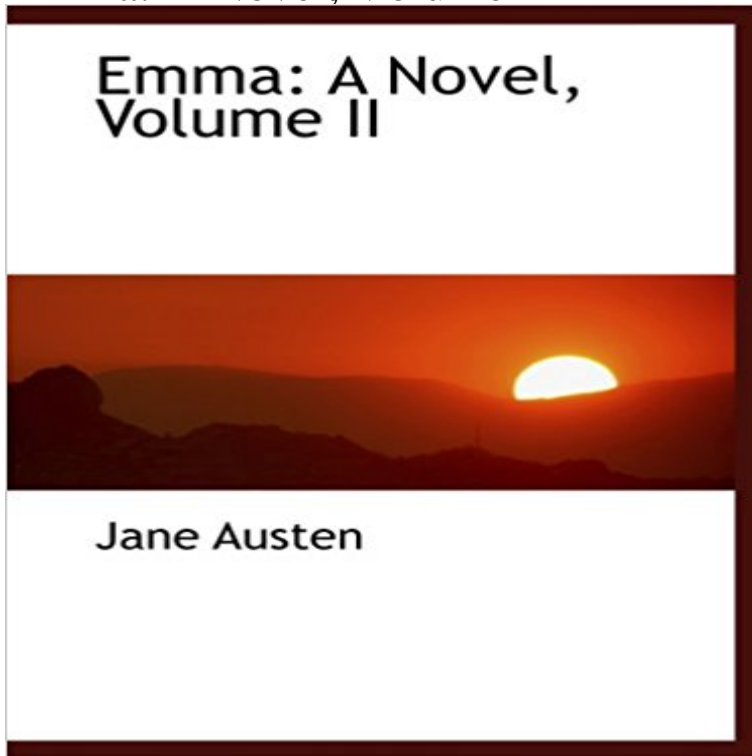


## Emma: A Novel, Volume II
