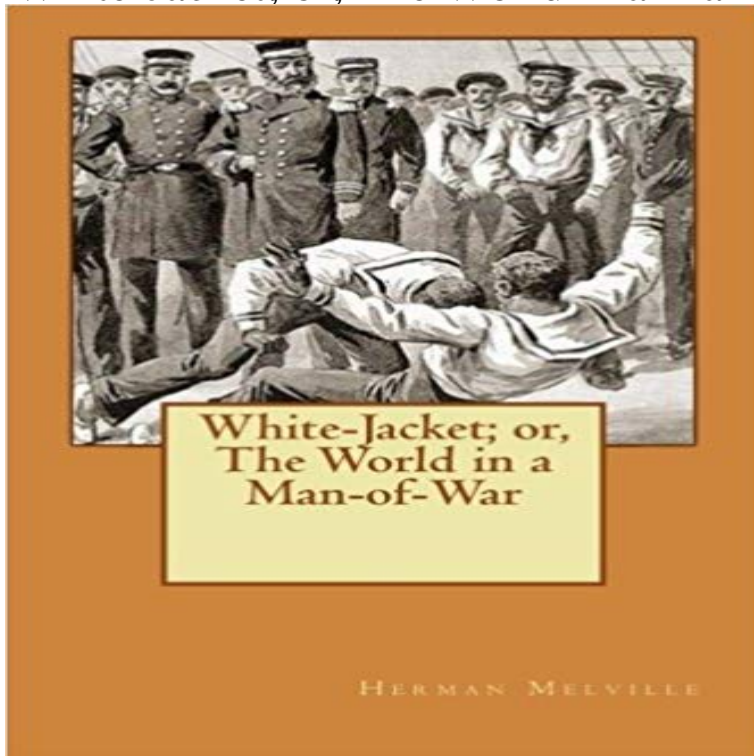


White-Jacket; or, The World in a Man-of-War
