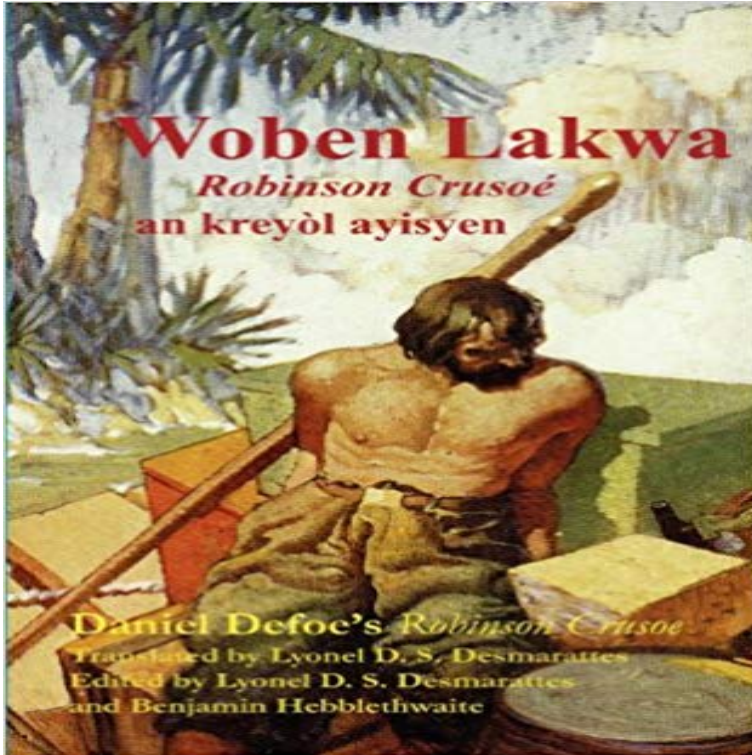


## Woben Lakwa: Robinson Crusoe in Haitian Creole (Haitian Edition)
