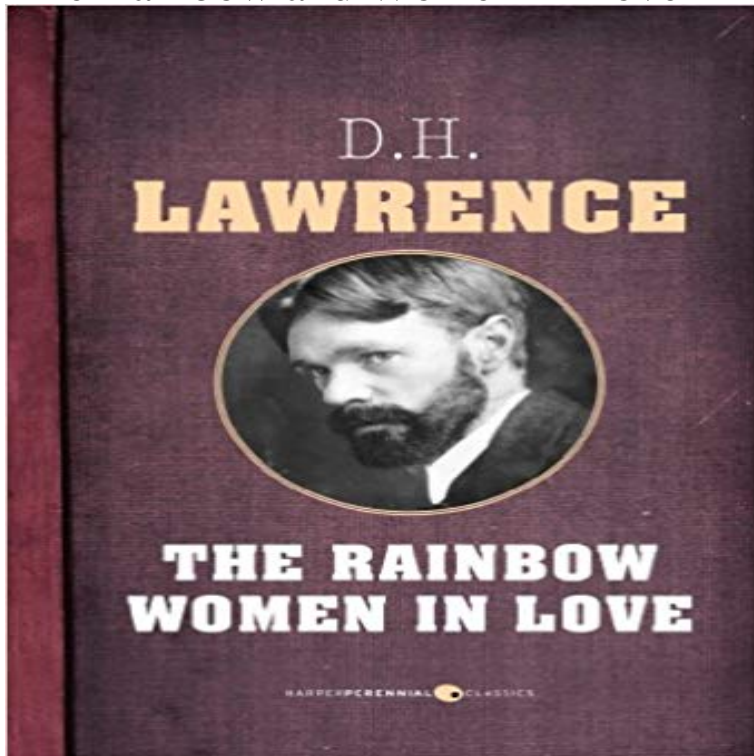


The Rainbow and Women In Love
